

Welcome to Great-Printable-Stuff.

You have purchased 16 front and 2 editable inside templates for Christmas cards. The main theme of the cards is based on “family”, showing cute and adorable pictures of animal family. There is also a small collection of other pictures to depict ‘family’.

Each card has the following quotation: ***“Christmas time is about family, friends and love”***. There are two inside templates to choose from:

Template 1: ***“Hoping the Christmas season fills your home with joy, love and laughter”***.

Template 2: ***“Warmest greeting for Christmas and the festive season. May you celebrate in high spirits and lots of laughter and love”***

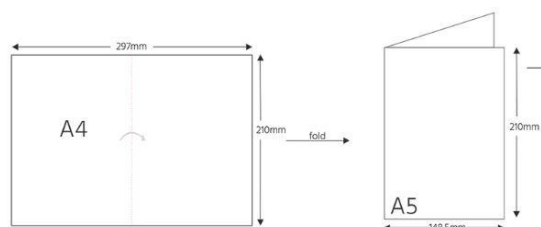
The insides of the cards are editable. If you want to hand write your message or name, just delete the text in the text box before printing (*ie the words “Type message here or delete”.*)

The front cards are combined into one pdf file, so when printing you only need to select the page you wish to print. If you want separated pdf files, contact me and I will split them for you or you can go to www.iLovePDF.com.

It is more professional if you print the fronts on a higher weight paper or light cardboard. It is not recommended that the weight exceeds 175GSM if you are printing on a home printer.

All cards are based on a foldable A4 page, giving an A5 size card (14.8 x 21 cm)

There are two inside templates for you to choose from. Both are editable on both sides of the page. See details below for editing tips. Its best to print the inside templates separate to the front cover and put back-to-back within the cover (just put a spot of glue to keep them together if you wish) before you fold the card. Fold together like this:



Information:

- 1 All pictures are from free licence. They cannot be edited or deleted.
- 2 The FRONT covers cannot be edited. The two editable pd files (the page 2 pdf files) can be edited by placing curser in the text box and typing. The text is fixed and left justified. Just open the file and start typing.
- 3 You cannot alter the font, font size or font colour. If you want to have bold or italic, the whole text box will change. You cannot have specific words bolded if they are in an un-bolded text box. Use the keyboard keys to either bold (Ctrl/Alt/B) or italic (Ctr/Alt/I). This will also reverse the change.
- 4 Be creative with your keys. Use capital letters to emphasize something and the space bar to put the text in another place.
- 5 You can save the file by selecting the save key which is on the top right-hand corner
- 6 If you do not need to use all the text boxes, you can leave empty (the text box shading disappears if no text is in it)
