5 Free Puzzles

Connect Matching Pairs without Crossing Lines

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How to Play

Each puzzle shows a large circle filled with lettered dots. Some dots sit on the outer edge of the circle, others are scattered inside. Every letter appears exactly twice — your job is to connect each matching pair with a single line.

The Rules

1. Connect each letter to its matching partner — A to A, B to B, C to C, and so on.
2. All lines must stay inside the outer circle.
3. Lines cannot cross each other.
4. Lines cannot pass through any dot (only connect at the matching dot).
5. Every dot must be used — no dot is left unconnected.
6. There is only a maximum of three lines that can pass between any two dots

A Few Tips

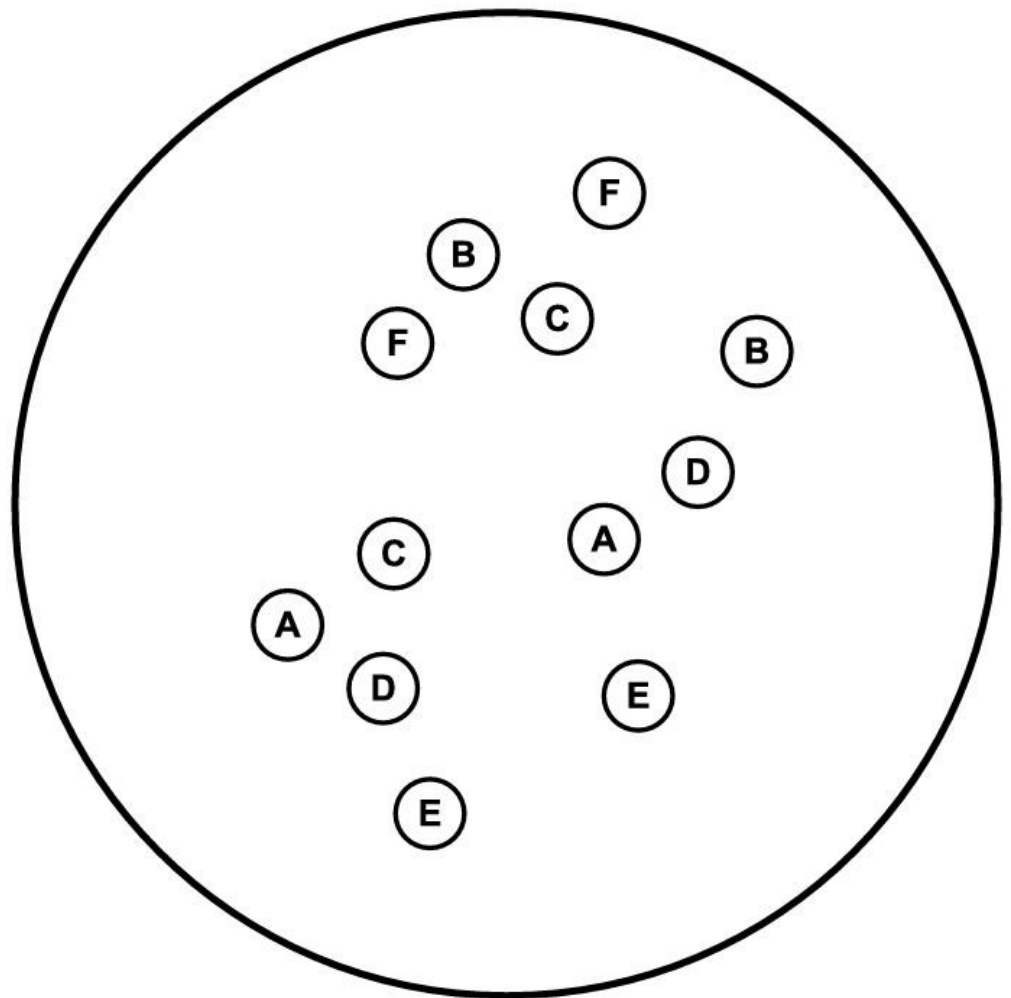
- Start with the dots that look easiest to connect — usually pairs where one dot is on the outer circle and the other is close by inside.
- Remember your line can travel in any direction — as long as it doesn't cross anything.
- If you get stuck, try working backwards — look at which gaps are still open and which pairs still need connecting.
- Use a pencil so you can erase and try a different route!
- Don't give up — every puzzle has a solution, even when it doesn't look like it!

Difficulty Guide

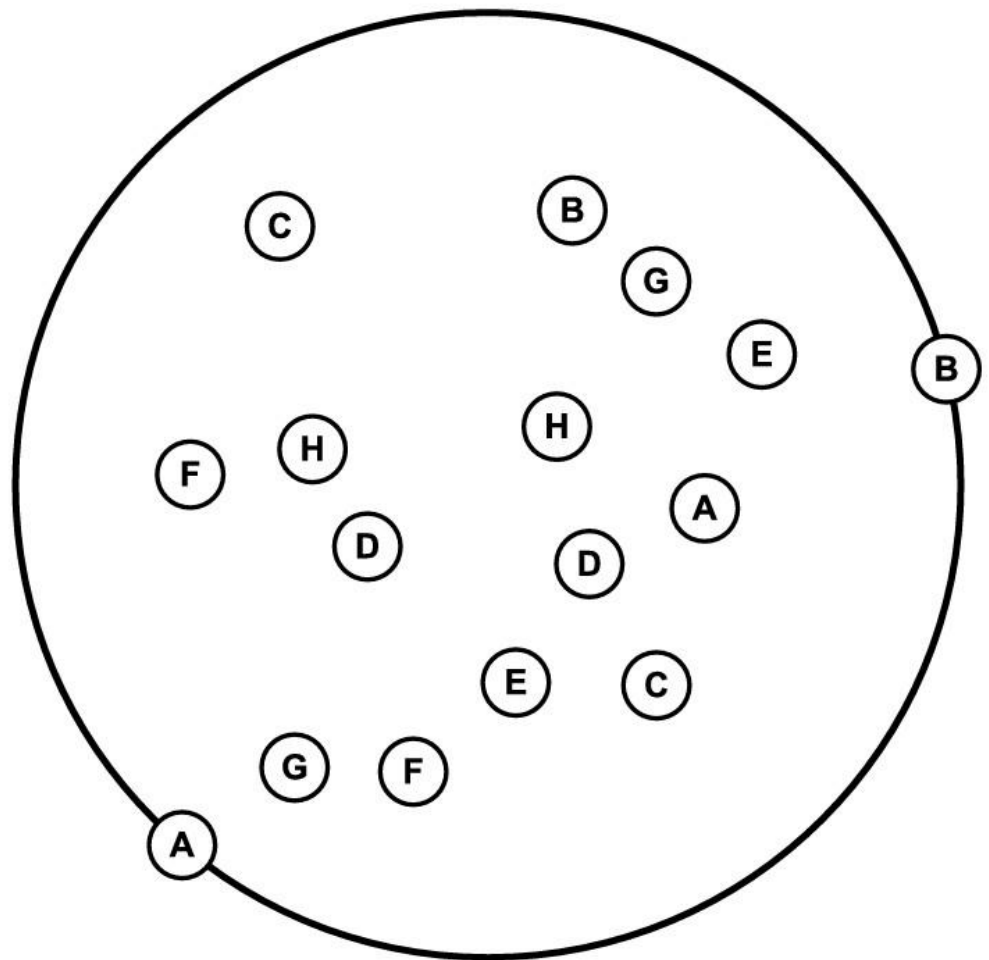
The puzzles in this book are arranged from easiest to hardest. Two things make a puzzle harder: more pairs to connect, and fewer dots sitting on the outer circle (meaning more dots are crowded inside, making routes trickier to find).

- **Starter (4 - 6 pairs):** Great for beginners and younger puzzlers. Fewer dots, more space, easier routes.
- **Junior (7–8 pairs):** A step up in challenge. You'll need to think a little more carefully about where your lines go.
- **Intermediate (9–10 pairs):** Now it gets interesting! Routes start to wind and weave around each other.
- **Advanced (11–12 pairs):** Seriously tricky. The circle fills up fast and every route matters.
- **Expert (13–14 pairs):** The ultimate challenge. Only the most determined puzzlers will conquer these!

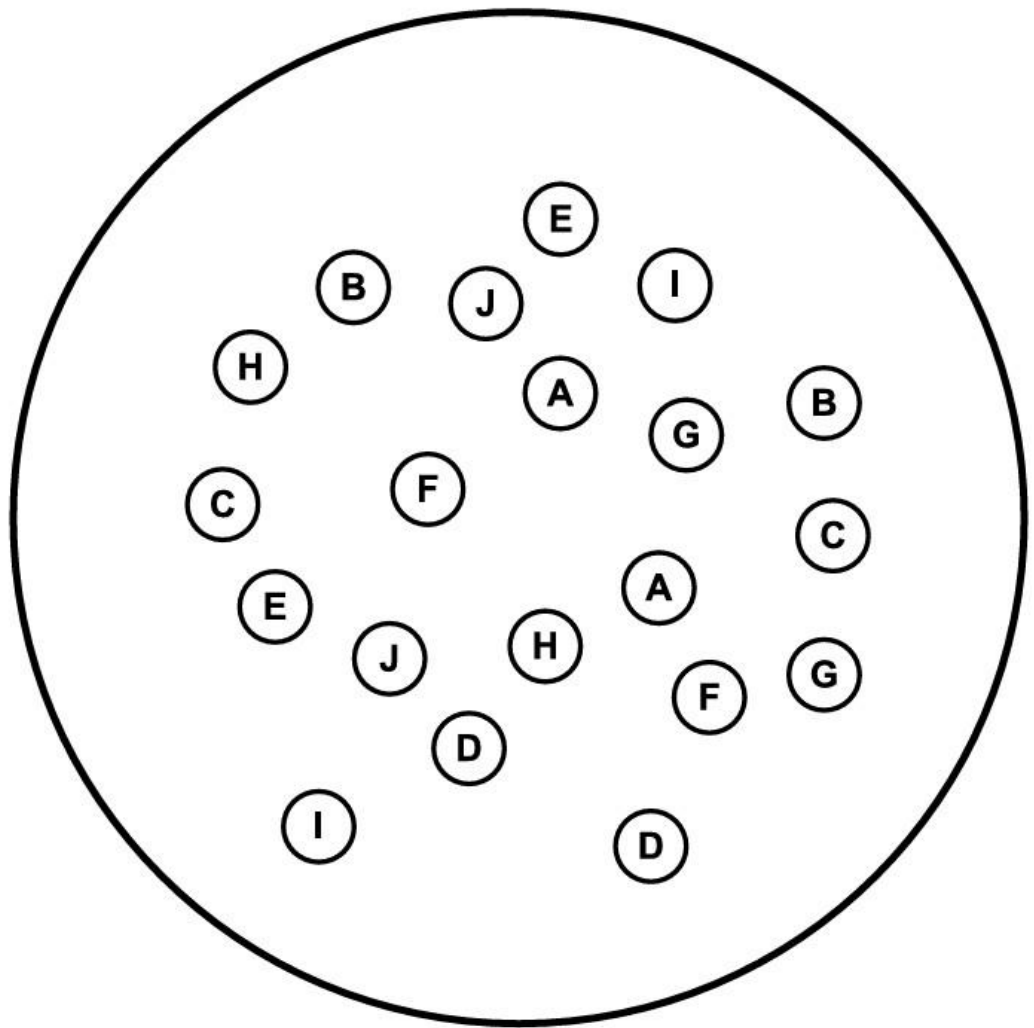
